A Brief Report of the Symposium/ Conference

The 17th Annual Conference of Gwalior Academy of Mathematical Sciences & National Symposium on Computational Mathematics and Information Technology was organized at Jaypee University of Engineering and Technology, Guna from 7th - 9th Dec, 2012.

The conference was inaugurated on 7th Dec 2012 by Prof. KNS Yadav, Vice Chancellor, Rani Durgawati University Jabalpur. The inaugural ceremony was presided over by Prof. N J Rao, VC (JUET).
