1. Counselling will be held online.
2. To ensure branch of their choice, candidates are suggested to apply under both the categories (JEE mains based and 10+2 based) separately and pay separate Application Fee.
3. JEE (Mains) application form is common to all the Universities. However, application for 10+2 based admission form is University specific to which candidate is seeking admission.
4. Admissions are non-transferable within the Jaypee Universities.
5. Dates may vary as per declaration of results of JEE mains and 10+2 (MP Board/ CBSE/ AISCSE, etc.)
6. Visit website www.juet.ac.in for further details.

2. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Application forms for admission through all modes in all programs are available online at www.juet.ac.in.
- 2.2 Application forms can also be obtained by post by sending a demand draft of application fee to “Admission Cell, Jaypee University of Engineering & Technology, AB Road, Raghogarh, Guna-473226 (M.P.)” or at the admission counters of all Jaypee Universities.
- 2.3 Candidates who procure the application form after payment of the application fee are not required to make any further payment while submitting the application form.
- 2.4 If a candidate is applying for JEE (Main) 2026 based admission but also wants to apply for 10+2 marks-based admission and/ or admission under NRI category, he/she must apply separately and pay the required application fee.
- 2.5 Applications received after the last date of submission will not be accepted and candidates shall have no claim on the merit list and subsequent admission to the program.
- 2.6 Hosting of the offline Application Forms of different programs on the website of the University shall be done in a phased manner. Candidates are required to check the website of the university, www.juet.ac.in regularly for the latest updates and take necessary action as per the information hosted on the website.
- 2.7 Display of Application Status: Candidates shall generally be able to see the receipt details of their applications and essential data on the website within two working days of submission of the Application form.
- 2.8 Candidates are advised to keep with them a copy of the e-mail along with the photocopy of the filled-in Application Form(s). In any case, all issues regarding non-receipt of Application form(s) in the Admission Cell must be resolved before declaration of merit list. No appeals thereafter will be entertained in this regard.

3. APPLICATION FEE

3.2 The Application fee can be paid through any of the following modes:

- (i) Online at Admission portal of www.juet.ac.in through internet banking/ debit card/ credit card/ UPI.
- (ii) JEE main based admission (Point 3.1 S.No.1) - Demand Draft in favor of “Jaypee Institutes Admission Account” payable at Noida/Delhi.
- (iii) For all other categories of admission, Demand Draft in favor of “Jaypee University of Engineering and Technology” payable at Guna.
- (iv) By debit card/ credit card/ UPI at the admission counter of the university.

4. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

4.1 B Tech Programs :

- a) Candidates who have passed 10+2/Equivalent exam in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026 are eligible to apply.
- b) The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent (as defined in JEE (Main) 2026 examination) with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Informatics Practices, Technical Vocational Subject, Agriculture, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship and English. For Civil Engineering/Chemical Engineering/Mechanical Engineering Programs, Chemistry is must with Physics and Mathematics.
- c) Candidates should have minimum of 60% marks (55% for SC/ ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination. Other conditions at 4.1(a) and 4.1(b) will remain same.
- d) Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to BTech will be required to submit a Gap Period affidavit available at the University Website www.juet.ac.in.
- e) Seats will be filled through Counselling based on JEE (mains) AIR (2026). Any remaining seats will be filled through university level Counselling based on 10+2 results.

4.2 BTech Programs (Lateral Entry):

- a. Passed Diploma in engineering with at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) OR
- b. Passed BTech 1st Year from a recognized University as defined by UGC , with at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) or equivalent CGPA in the same branch in which admission in BTech 2nd year is sought. OR
- c. Passed BSc Degree from a recognized University as defined by UGC, with at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) and passed 10+2 with mathematics as a subject. OR
- d. Passed B.VOC/ 3-year D.VOC Stream in the same or allied sector in the same discipline.

4.3 BBA Program:

- a. Candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 or equivalent examination from a recognized educational board.
- b. Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to BBA will be required to submit a Gap Period affidavit available at the University Website www.juet.ac.in.

4.4 Diploma Program - Candidate should have passed or appeared in 2026 in 10th or equivalent examination from a recognized educational board with Science and Mathematics as subjects. For direct entry into 2nd year Diploma, candidates should have passed ITI in relevant branch or passed 10+2 examination with Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics/Computer Science/Electronics/IT.

4.5 MSc Program – Candidates should have passed BSc (Hons)/BSc under 10+2+3 pattern securing the minimum of 55% marks (50% for SC/ST) or equivalent grade point on a 10-point scale in the aggregate in science subjects (considering all the three years of BSc course). The subject in which admission is sought must be the Hons. subject at BSc (Hons.) Level/ a subject studied in all three years at undergraduate level.

4.6 MTech Program – Candidates should have passed BE/BTech examination with 60% marks or 6.0 CGPA on 10-point scale in the relevant discipline.

4.7 PhD Program – PG degree with 55% (50% for SC/ST) marks from a recognized University/Institution in the relevant subject in regular mode. Admission will be based on the PhD entrance test followed by interview conducted at JUET, Guna. NET/SLET/GATE qualified candidates are exempted from appearing in the PhD Entrance test but will have to appear in the interview.

4.8 All admissions will be subject to verification of facts from the original certificates/documents of the candidates. If an applicant is found ineligible at a later stage after admission to the University, his/her admission will stand automatically cancelled. The decision of the Admissions Committee of the University regarding the eligibility for admission to the program shall be final and binding on the candidate.

4.9 Ensuring eligibility for the admission to the program, under the defined category of admission, is the sole responsibility of the candidate.

4.10 Candidates appearing in qualifying examinations prescribed above in the year 2026 can also apply for admission. However, if admission is based on marks of the qualifying examination, the result of the examination must be submitted before the preparation of merit list as per admission calendar 2026.

5. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM

5.1 Application form for admission can be submitted ONLINE or OFFLINE.

5.2 For Online Applications :

- a) Log on to www.juet.ac.in and click on Apply online link of the related program
- b) Thereafter, follow the on-screen prompts to fill up the application form and make the payment through Credit card/Debit card/Net banking/UPI.
- c) Once the payment has been successfully made, the candidate shall be allotted an Application ID, which must be preserved for future reference. The candidate shall also get an e-mail of confirmation.
- d) During the online application, candidates are required to upload the passport size photograph of self and signatures of self and the parent.
- e) Candidates should keep a copy of the application form for all future references.
- f) Process to be followed if payment of application fee is to be made through Demand Draft:
 - i. Submit the application form on-line.
 - ii. Take a print out of application form and attach the Demand Draft with it made in favour of “Jaypee University of Engineering & Technology”, payable at Guna.
 - iii. Send the same by post to Admission Cell , Jaypee University of Engineering & Technology ,AB Road, Raghogarh, Guna, 473226, (MP).

5.3 For Offline Application forms procured from Admission Counter of the University:

- a) Fill-in the Application Form neatly without any cut/overwriting with black/blue pen.
- b) Fill-in all fields, affix the photograph and sign the application form.
- c) For JEE (Main) 2026 based admission, JEE application number and JEE Roll number should be filled at appropriate places in the application form. Hard copy of the filled application form to be submitted to:

6. RESERVATION OF SEATS

- 6.1** Reservation for SC/ST/Kashmiri Migrant candidates will be as per the provisions of GOI for all programs.
- 6.2** 10% seats at JUET, Guna are reserved for wards of serving and retired Armed Forces and Paramilitary Forces Personnel.
- 6.3** A concession of 30% in tuition fee is available for the candidates admitted under the categories given in point 6.2 above. An additional 5% concession in tuition fee is also available for the wards of war widows and personnel martyred in action.

7. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - JEE (MAIN) 2026 RANK BASED B.TECH ADMISSION (ONLINE COUNSELLING)

- 7.1** The merit list amongst the Applications received for admission to Jaypee Universities shall be drawn based on All India Rank in JEE (Main) 2026 Examination. Rank in no other category will be considered for drawing merit.
- 7.2 COUNSELLING INTIMATION:** Counselling will be based on Merit. Shortlisted candidates eligible for counselling will be informed by email on registered mail IDs. List of candidates will also be uploaded in the website.

7.3 COUNSELLING: The first round of Counselling will be common and conducted by JIIT Noida for admissions to all the four universities, i.e. JIIT-Noida, JUIT-Waknaghat, JUET-Guna and JU-Anoopshahr. The subsequent round(s) of Counselling will be conducted by respective Universities

7.4 PROCESS OF COUNSELLING:

- (a) The Counselling will be held in online mode.
- (b) All applicants to upload their JEE Mains 2026 results on get admissions portal as per the schedule of Counselling. Candidates are also required to upload the 10+2 marksheet.
- (c) Eligible candidates if desirous will have the option to amend/ update their choices before the scheduled Counselling date.
- (d) Initial fee of Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees Sixty thousand only) to be deposited. The amount will be adjusted against academic fee dues of first semester for candidates who are admitted or will be kept as wait listed fee till admission is offered.
- (e) Allocation of seats will be as per merit of JEE (Mains) AIR 2026 and as per the preferences indicated in the choice form.
- (f) On allocation of a seat, candidate will be sent Provisional Admission Letter. The communication will be sent to registered email id and mobile number. The details will also be visible in the candidate's Counselling portal.
- (g) The candidate should pay the balance fees as mentioned in the offer letter within the due date to confirm the admission.
- (h) The candidate shall have the option of upgradation in the programs/ branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them.

Note:

- 1. Candidates are advised to judiciously fill their choice(s) before submitting their choice form.
- 2. Instructions regarding detailed conduct of counselling will be updated on the website as per counselling schedule.
- 3. Only the candidates who have uploaded clear copy (should include the CRL (Common Rank List) and (QR Code) of JEE Main-2026 in their application form, will be considered for counselling.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE - 10+2 BASED B.TECH ADMISSION (THROUGH UNIVERSITY LEVEL ONLINE COUNSELLING)

8.1 A separate application form must be filled in by the students for JUET, Guna seeking admission in B. Tech programs based on 10+2.

8.2 Counselling Process :

- a) The 10+2 based online Counselling will be conducted by JUET, Guna on the scheduled dates mentioned above in the admission calendar 2026. Any change in the admission calendar 2026 will be notified for the information of the candidates well in time by the university.
- b) The merit shall be drawn based on marks obtained in 10+2 in Mathematics and Physics and one subject as mentioned in Section 4.1 (b) with highest score. Candidates are responsible for uploading their results before preparation of merit list.
- c) Applications with incomplete documents/results of 10+2 will not be considered for Counselling.
- d) The eligible candidates, if desirous, will have the option to amend/ update their choices before the scheduled Counselling date.
- e) Eligible candidates will be allotted branches as per their choice and merit on the due date of counselling and informed in e-mail through their registered e-mail id. Candidates are advised to check their email for counselling intimation.

- f) On allocation of a seat, the candidate would be required to deposit Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty thousand) towards partial academic fee of the program. The amount will be adjusted against academic fee dues of first semester for candidates who are admitted or will be kept as wait listed fee till admission is offered.
- g) The candidate will be sent Provisional Admission Letter after the payment of partial fee. The communication will be sent to registered email id and mobile number.
- h) The candidate will be required to pay the balance fees as mentioned in the offer letter within the due date to confirm the admission.

Note:

1. Candidates are advised to judiciously fill in their choice(s) before submitting their choice form.
2. Instructions regarding detailed conduct of Counselling will be updated on the website as per Counselling schedule.

8.3 Allocation of Seats

- (a) Seats in the programs of study shall be allotted based on preferences opted by the candidate, strictly in order of merit drawn based on marks scored in 10+2 in the 3 subjects as given in Para 8.2 (b).
- (b) Eligible candidates, if desirous, will have option to amend/update their choices. NRI stands for Non-Resident Indian, referring to an Indian citizen who resides outside India for work, business, education, or due to other reasons.

9. ADMISSION PROCEDURE – 10+2 MARKS BASED B T.ECH ADMISSION UNDER NRI CATEGORY

- 9.1 The merit shall be drawn amongst the applications received under NRI /NRI sponsored category based on the marks obtained in three subjects in 10+2 as given in Section 4.1 (b) under General Eligibility Criteria.
- 9.2 Candidates will be allotted seats strictly in order of merit. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission, subject to production of certificates of eligibility/ qualification and depositing of applicable Academic fee. The selected candidates will be informed about the allotted seats along with other relevant information through e-mail by the respective Universities. The candidate must therefore give their correct primary Email ID for communication.
- 9.3 Candidates who take admission under this category cannot opt for change to General/ Non-NRI category in subsequent years of the entire program duration.
- 9.4 Those who have already passed 10+2 examination should fill 10+2 marks in the application form and Attach a photocopy of the marks sheet.
- 9.5 Candidates appearing in 10+2 examination of year 2026 should submit their results by the last date of application. Candidates who fail to submit their 10+2 marks sheet by the due date will not be considered for admission.
- 9.6 All candidates should compulsorily attach Sponsorship Letter from NRI or NRI certificate, as the case May be, along with the application form.
- 9.7 In case of offline application form, the completed application form must be submitted or sent to the University on the address given in para 5.3(d) above. On the top of the envelope, please mention “Application under NRI/ NRI Sponsored Category”

10. ADMISSION PROCEDURE-LATERAL ENTRY ADMISSION TO 2ND YEAR B.TECH PROGRAM

Based on the applications received and meeting the eligibility criteria, merit shall be prepared based on CGPA/ Marks obtained in Diploma/B Tech 1st year/ BSc/ D. Voc Admission shall be offered based on the merit.

11. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - DIPLOMA PROGRAM

A merit will be drawn based on marks of qualifying examination results. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee.

12. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - MSC PROGRAM

A merit will be drawn based on marks of qualifying examination results. Selected candidates will be offered Provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee.

13. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - M.TECH PROGRAM

Candidates meeting the eligibility criteria will be required to appear in the PGET conducted by JUET, Guna. A merit will be drawn based on marks obtained in PGET. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee. GATE qualified candidates are exempted from appearing in PGET.

14. ADMISSION PROCEDURE PHD PROGRAM

Admission to PhD Program will be done through PhD Entrance Test followed by interview conducted by JUET Guna. NET/SLET/GATE qualified candidates are exempted from appearing in PhD Entrance Test. However, they will be required to appear for the interview conducted by the respective department. Admission will be offered purely on the basis of PhD Entrance Test Result and/or Interview. The admission will be provisional and subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of academic fee.

15. ADMISSION PROCEDURE BBA PROGRAM

A merit will be drawn based on marks of qualifying examination results. Selected candidates shall be offered provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee.

The conditions for payouts shall be as under:-

- 1) The scholarship amounts are subject to approval of tuition fees by regulatory authority.
- 2) The academic fee to be paid in full each semester.
- 3) Scholarship to be paid equivalent to eligible amount at the end of each Academic Year.
- 4) For continuation of scholarships, students need to maintain minimum CGPA ≥ 7.0 at the end of each year.
- 5) There should not be disciplinary action against the students.

16.4 M Tech Program

- 1) Teaching Assistantships of Rs 15000/- per month will be provided to students with valid GATE score.
- 2) Candidates with CGPA = 7.5 or more in qualifying degree will also receive TA of Rs. 15000/- per month.
- 3) For subsequent semesters TA will be admissible, subject to meeting the minimum CGPA ≥ 7.5 or more and other conditions as laid down in the M. Tech. regulations.
- 4) TA will be provided to students who are admitted in MTech program after the last date of admission for AY 2026-27 (from Oct 2026 for first semester).

16.5 PhD Program

A teaching Assistantship fellowship of Rs.45,000/- per month is provided to the full-time research scholars who are non-recipient of any other fellowships.

- Hostel Charges** - Hostel Charges (if allotted) per semester including food and laundry shall be Rs. 84000/- for Non-NRI Category and USD 1150 for NRI Category. The charges are applicable for the AY

2026-27. The charges are subject to revision due to hike in the cost of commodities and other associate facilities as and when deemed fit by the Management.

18. REFUND POLICY

Last date of admission is as allowed /communicated by regulatory bodies. If a student leaves the program, fee shall be refunded as per UGC/AICTE Notifications.

Refund of Hostel Charges:

- a) Till the date of Registration in program, a candidate is entitled for full refund of advance of Hostel charges, provided the student does not occupy the Hostel in advance.
- b) From the date of Registration in the program, the amount shall be refunded on pro-rata monthly basis, even if student has not occupied the Hostel or not taken the key to the room.
- c) For calculation of pro-rata deduction/refund, the duration of the semester as per the academic calendar shall be considered and deduction shall be made on per month basis, even if hostel is occupied for part of a month i.e. even for a single day only.
- d) Refund after reporting at the allotted University is subject to submission of No Dues
